A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE REPRESENTATIVES OF THIS CITY TO ALLOCATE FUNDS FROM THEIR COUNTRYWIDE DEVELOPMENT FUNDS (CDF) TO DEFRAY THE COST OF ANNUAL EXECUTIVE MEDICAL CHECK-UP FOR ALL THE BARANGAY CAPTAINS OF DISTRICTS I, II AND III OF THIS CITY AT THE PHILIPPINE HEART CENTER.

WHEREAS, as Chief Executives of our Barangay Government, our Barangay Captains have always served as the backbone of our most basic local government units – setting aside personal and financial gain, enduring and rising above challenges and hardships that take its toll on their health and physical well-being;

WHEREAS, despite their enormous task, our Barangay Captains receive a relatively meager honoraria for their services and yet continue in the discharge of their responsibilities and obligations – one might say that they serve beyond the call of duty;

WHEREAS, for risking their lives and setting aside their health concerns, it is high time that our Barangay Captains be provided with incentives in ensuring that they are always in the pink of health as they discharge their multifarious responsibilities to the community and the city;

WHEREAS, the program of providing executive medical check-up for all Barangay Captains of this City is inspired by the same program initiated by District IV Representative, Honorable Nanette Castelo-Daza for the 38 Barangay Captains of District IV at the Philippine Heart Center;




