WHEREAS, the State was mandated by the Constitution to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them, in this commitment to this responsibility, the special needs of the women should not be set aside;

WHEREAS, medical experts have identified certain illnesses that are inflicting primarily, if not exclusively, women, some of these are breast cancer, immune dysfunction, and the mimicry of female human estrogen;

WHEREAS, the increasingly alarming number of cases caused by these diseases demands prompt response from the government agencies concerned, appropriate action and further studies, require solid facts that would rightfully place the theoretical solutions in the proper context;

WHEREAS, this bill mandates the Secretary of the Department of Health (DOH) to submit a report on the effects of environmental factors on women's health, such report will be relevant material for medical experts in finding a possible cure to the diseases, and for lawmakers as well in drafting necessary legislation that will provide a comprehensive solution to the problem.




