RESOLUTION NO. SP **2215**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING HER EXCELLENCY, MADAME PRESIDENT GLORIA MACAPAGAL-ARROYO, TO PROCLAIM THAT PARCEL OF LAND WHICH IS BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY UNIVERSITY AVENUE, ON THE EAST BY CARLOS P. GARCIA AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH BY MAN-MADE CREEK (MAKATARUNGAN AND MALIWANAG STREETS), ON THE WEST BY CULIAT CREEK, AND LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAN VICENTE, QUEZON CITY, TO BE AWARDED/SOLD TO DESERVING AND QUALIFIED OCCUPANTS THEREAT UNDER THE COMMUNITY MORTGAGE PROGRAM (CMP) WHERE THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AS THE ORIGINATOR.

WHEREAS, the residents of that parcel of land, formerly known as the Signal Battalion Philippines Enlisted Men's Barrio, located in Barangay San Vicente, have for so many decades been clamoring for an opportunity to own the piece of land they occupy with the assistance of concerned authorities or government instrumentalities;

WHEREAS, Barangay San Vicente has been declared one of the Zonal Improvement Program areas of the City in line with the government's efforts of uplifting the living conditions in slum and blighted areas and the eventual land acquisition by the landless residents;

WHEREAS, the residents of Barangay San Vicente have occupied their respective premises ranging from twenty to forty-five (20-45) years and have developed and introduced improvements thereon and, therefore, deserve the solicitous concern of the government in pursuance of its responsibility of enhancing the living standard of its constituents;

WHEREAS, improvements introduced and found in Barangay San Vicente that could measure its development and need for proclamation and lot distribution to qualified occupants are: elementary school compound, electricity, telecommunication facilities, concrete/asphalted roads, house-to-house potable water supply connection, concrete house/structures, etc.

Garcia Avenue, on the south by a man-made creek (Makatarungan and Maliwanag Streets), on the west by Culiati Creek, and located in Barangay San Vicente, Quezon City, to be awarded/sold to deserving and qualified occupants thereat under the Community Mortgage Program (CMP) where the Quezon City government as the originator.
