RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2219, S-2003

A RESOLUTION APPEALING TO HIS HONOR BAYANI FERNANDO, CHAIRMAN, METRO MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) TO EXEMPT AND SPARE IN THE DEMOLITION OR CLEARING OPERATION OF CITY STREETS, THE EXISTING SEVERAL STRUCTURES AND BARANGAY HALL BUILDING OCCUPYING A PORTION OR PARTLY OF THE SIDEWALK OF DOÑA JUANA RODRIGUEZ STREET LOCATED AT BARANGAY KALUSUGAN, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, AS THESE FACILITIES WERE USED AS BARANGAY CENTER, BARANGAY HALL, INFORMATION AND READING CENTER, BARANGAY CHAPEL, DAY-CARE LEARNING CENTER, HEALTH STATION, SK HALL, LIVELIHOOD CENTER, KATARUNGANG PAMBARANGAY HALL AND BARANGAY TANOD POST AND FURTHER DOES NOT IMPEDE OR DISTURB THE SMOOTH FLOW OF TRAFFIC IN THE AREA.

WHEREAS, there are several structures found along Doña Juana Rodriguez Street, Barangay Kalusugan, District IV, Quezon City, occupying portion of the sidewalks which were used a long time ago and up to the present by barangay officials as barangay hall, barangay center, information and reading center, barangay chapel, day-care learning center, health station, SK hall, livelihood center, Katarungang Pambarangay hall and barangay tanod post;

WHEREAS, these structures were built on this area considering that there are no available vacant lots or area within the jurisdiction of Barangay Kalusugan either government or private lots which can be used to house the above-mentioned facilities for the residents and for barangay officials in the exercise and performance of their official function;


WHEREAS, the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod as well as the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Kalusugan, this City, are well and much aware of the sincere and serious clean up operations of Metro Manila Development Authority, headed by Honorable Bayani Fernando to clean Metro Manila streets of illegal structures, unauthorized billboards, and signages that cause traffic jams or impede the smooth flow of traffic in the area;

WHEREAS, the structures above-mentioned although appearing to be occupying portion of sidewalks of Doña Juana Rodriguez Street, the same does not disturb or impede the smooth flow of traffic nor block the passage of vehicle going in and out considering that it is not only a barangay or interior street but also there is less volume of traffic created anytime of the day;

WHEREAS, there is a need to request and make an appeal to His Honor, Bayani Fernando of Metro Manila Development Authority, for and in behalf of the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Kalusugan and residents thereat to spare and exempt these structures occupying partly of the sidewalks of Doña Juana Rodriguez Street from demolition or of his city streets clearing operation as there will be more losses than benefits that may be experienced and realized by our constituents and further on the above-mentioned grounds.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to appeal, as it does hereby appeal, to His Honor Bayani Fernando, Chairman, Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) to exempt and spare in the demolition or clearing operation of city streets, the existing several structures and barangay hall building occupying a portion or partly of the sidewalk of Doña Juana Rodriguez Street located at Barangay Kalusugan, District IV, Quezon City as these facilities were used as barangay center, barangay hall, information and reading center, barangay chapel, day care learning center, health station, SK hall, livelihood center, katarungang pambarangay hall and barangay tanod post and further does not impede or disturb the smooth flow of traffic in the area.


