A RESOLUTION URGING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO INITIATE AND UNDERTAKE A STUDY THE POSSIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING, ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING A SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT CENTER FOR URBAN STREET CHILDREN.

WHEREAS, a dignified center of human habitation, a decent focus of commerce, business and industry, and vying to recapture the great honor of being the capital of the Republic can be expressed well by giving second life and new hope for the young children in the street as they shall be the living testimony of our accomplishments worthy of glory and dignity this Council has done for this City.


WHEREAS, there is a felt need, therefore, to take care of said street children who are homeless and denied of the pleasures and comfort of a family, and to give them a decent means of livelihood.
