RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2246, S-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) EACH TO CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT (CPD) POLICEMEN WHO ARE TOTALLY AND PERMANENTLY PHYSICALLY DISABLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY.

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 18 of the Office of the City Mayor provides financial assistance in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) to the family of a policeman who dies in the line of duty;

WHEREAS, in the discharge of their critical role and risky task of maintaining peace and order in Quezon City, certain CPD policemen have been or could be maimed for life but there is no pronouncement from the local government to extend to them financial assistance to compensate for their service-connected permanent physical disability, over and above other benefits and remunerations that they are entitled under the law;

WHEREAS, the permanent physical disability of a CPD policeman consequently necessitates his untimely and compulsory retirement from the service of the Philippine National Police (PNP), to the prejudice of his family who have to suffer the adverse effect of his meager pension, his loss of earning capacity, and his lifetime handicap;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned distressing situation of CPD policemen concerned should likewise be taken cognizance of and addressed by the City government by extending financial assistance in recognition and appreciation of their selfless and devoted service in the maintenance of peace and order in Quezon City which consequently resulted to their permanent physical disability.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, to grant financial assistance in the amount of Thirty Thousand Pesos (P30,000.00) each to Central Police District policemen who are totally and permanently physically disabled in the line of duty.
