
RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2269**S-2003

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR, FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO PROVIDE ECONOMIC RELIEF ASSISTANCE IN THE FORM OF ADDITIONAL LOCAL ALLOWANCE, RICE SUBSIDY, INCREASE IN HAZARD PAY AND IN ORDER FOR THE QUEZON CITY PAROLE AND PROBATION OFFICERS TO PARTLY ALLEVIATE THEIR ECONOMIC CONDITIONS TO BE TAKEN FROM THE BUDGET OF THE CITY MAYOR OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, for the past twenty-six (26) years, their office had been partner of the City government in providing economical and effective alternative to imprisonment by granting probation and services that they provide to Quezonians;







Belmonte, Jr., to provide economic relief assistance in the form of additional local allowance, rice subsidy, increase in hazard pay and in order for the Quezon City Parole and Probation Officers to partly alleviate their economic conditions to be taken from the budget of the Office of the City Mayor or from any available funds of the City.
