RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2272**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE SIXTEEN (16) FAMILIES WHO WERE VICTIMS OF THE FIRE THAT RAZED BLOCK 5 HILLCREST STREET, E. RODRIGUEZ AVENUE, BARANGAY IMMACULATE CONCEPCION, CUBAO, ON JULY 2003.

WHEREAS, a fire occurred in Hillcrest Street, E. Rodriguez Avenue, Barangay Immaculate Concepcion, Cubao, on July 28, 2003, victimizing sixteen (16) families;

WHEREAS, it has been the practice of the City government to help victims of unfortunate event by way of financial assistance to support them in their hour of need:

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, financial assistance to the sixteen (16) families who were victims of the fire that razed Block 5, Hillcrest Street, E. Rodriguez Avenue, Barangay Immaculate Concepcion, Cubao, on July 28, 2003, the amount to be taken from the Calamity or Emergency Fund or from any available fund of the City government as follows:

FAMILY OWNERS	-	P 4,000.00/ each
FAMILY RENTERS/ SHARERS	-	P 2,000.00/ each

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Office of the City Mayor shall revalidate and confirm the list submitted by the SSDD which shall be the basis for the preparation of the payroll and cause the immediate release of the fund allocated for the purpose.
