RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2278**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00) TO BE KNOWN AS SENIOR CITIZENS THEATER FUND, PROVIDING FREE ADMISSION TO SENIOR CITIZENS IN MOVIE HOUSES, THEATERS AND CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, senior citizens in Quezon City enjoy twenty percent (20%) discount as provided under Section 4 paragraphs (a) and (b) of R.A. 7432;


WHEREAS, Quezon City desires to give increased privileges to its senior citizens, to make life more livable in their sunset years;

WHEREAS, the City government can afford to extend a hundred percent discount on cinema admission to senior citizens thru tax credits for the theater owners.


NOW, THEREFORE,


