RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2280**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY TREASURER TO SEPARATE THE TEN PERCENT (10%) SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN SHARES FROM THE REAL PROPERTY TAX SHARES ACCRUING TO ALL BARANGAYS PRIOR TO ITS REMITTANCE AND DISTRIBUTION TO THEIR RESPECTIVE ACCOUNTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the City government to give fiscal autonomy to all its component barangays. In order to realize this policy, all the income of the barangay sourced from the real property tax share shall accrue to its general fund and shall, at the option of the barangay concerned, be kept by the Barangay Treasurer or be deposited in a bank, preferably government-owned, situated in or nearest to its area of jurisdiction. Such funds shall be disbursed in accordance with the existing rules and regulations issued by the Commission on Audit (COA) and other issuances promulgated by the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG);

WHEREAS, it is likewise the policy of the City government to encourage and enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of the Sangguniang Kabataan as partner of the City government in building a quality city and to allow the Sangguniang Kabataan officials to fast track the implementation of plans, programs and projects, the benefits of which are intended to all youths in every barangay. Towards this end, the Sangguniang Kabataan, in its effort to effectively and efficiently serve its youth constituents shall enjoy fiscal autonomy as a necessary ingredient for its effective and efficient performance of its powers, functions, duties and responsibilities;

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer is mandated to release the shares of the barangay from the proceeds of the basic real property tax, including interests thereon, and proceeds from the use, lease or disposition, sale or redemption of property acquired at a public auction, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code, subject to existing accounting rules and regulations issued by the Commission on Audit and other issuances by the Department of Interior and Local Government Code.


NOW, THEREFORE,


