RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2281**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION GRANTING ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES TO THE FIFTEEN (15) PETITIONERS FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE PLYING WITHIN THE ROUTE AND TERRITORY OF BARANGAY CENTRAL COVERED BY AGHAM TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION, INC., (AGHAM TODA).

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizing the importance of an efficient and inexpensive transportation facility as one of the basic necessities which must always be made available to the riding public;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 09-2002 passed by the Agham Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association, Inc., seeks additional Fifteen (15) Route Measure Capacity to augment the increasing commuters in that franchise route;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 161, Series of 2002 of the Barangay Council of Central likewise interposes no objection to the additional fifteen tricycle units;

WHEREAS, the grant of additional franchises to the petitioners substantial legalization will dramatically diminish the colorum tricycle.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to grant, as it does hereby grant, additional franchises to the Fifteen (15) petitioners for the operation of motorized tricycles for hire to ply within its route and territory of Agham Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association
