A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT (DOLE) FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RURAL WORKS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government is implementing the Rural Works Program, which guidelines are provided for in DOLE Department Order No. 061, Series of 1998, with the objective of assisting the out-of-school youth/displaced workers through emergency wage employment based on labor-intensive program and other projects;

WHEREAS, the City Treasury issued a certification that there are available funds in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Pesos (P178,880.00) representing the forty percent (40%) share of the City for the cleaning/declogging of Ilang-Ilang Paltok Creek, Barangay Commonwealth;

WHEREAS, these expenses will be charged against the item Other Expenses-others, subject to the approval of the City Mayor;

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor and Employment shall pay sixty percent (60%) of the wages and salaries of the out-of-school youths/displaced workers equivalent to Two Hundred Fifty Six Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Pesos (P256,320.00);
