RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2289** , S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ANY REPUTABLE CONTRACTOR FOR THE CONSTRUCTIONS OF PATHWALKS, MULTI-PURPOSE HALLS AND/OR DAY CARE CENTERS, WAITING SHEDS AND/OR TRICYCLE TERMINALS AND INSTALLATION OF ARTESIAN WELLS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN DISTRICT III OF QUEZON CITY, IN AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P2,500,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LUMP SUM APPROPRIATION FUND UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR.

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WHEREAS, the constructions of pathwalks, multi-purpose hall and/or day care centers, waiting sheds and/or tricycle terminals and installation of artesian wells in the different barangays located in the third district of Quezon City, are among the priority development projects of the Quezon City government;

WHEREAS, such development project is aimed to deliver basic services to the residents of third district of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there is a sense of urgency and a felt need to immediately finish said projects in order to provide for the comfort and convenience of the residents of said barangays;

WHEREAS, in order to avoid unnecessary delay which normally attends public bidding, there is a felt need to authorized the City Mayor of Quezon City, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable contractor for the improvement and concreting of pathwalks or alleys, construction of multi-purpose halls and/or day-care centers, waiting sheds and/or tricycle terminals and installation of artesian wells in the different barangays of the third district of Quezon City;


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WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) (vi) of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "the city mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance".


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, Quezon City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable contractor for the constructions of pathwalks, multi-purpose halls and/or day care centers, waiting sheds and/or tricycle terminals and installation of artesian wells at various locations in district three of Quezon City in an amount not exceeding Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,500,000.00) to be charged against the Lump Sum Appropriation Fund (Capital Outlay Infrastructure Fund) under the Office of the City Mayor.
