RESOLUTION NO. SP **2296** S-2003

A RESOLUTION URGING QUEZON CITY MAYOR HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO HASTEN AND FACILITATE THE IMMEDIATE IMPLEMENTATION OF ALL INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS AND THE RELEASE OF FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE FUNDED UNDER THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF QUEZON CITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2003 AND IMPROVE THE ADMINISTRATIVE MACHINERY OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT INVOLVED IN THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, in order to attain the said purpose, it becomes necessary to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the administrative machinery of the City government which are involved in the award of contracts and lessen the bureaucratic red tape which stands in the way towards the ultimate and complete implementation of said projects;
