A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH THE MERCURY DRUGSTORE FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MEDICINAL REQUIREMENTS AND OTHER MEDICAL BENEFIT OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND ITS EMPLOYEES, RESPECTIVELY.





WHEREAS, the local government of Quezon City in addressing the needs to provide the medicinal requirements of concerned offices/departments of the City intends to enter into a negotiated contract with the Mercury Drugstore;

WHEREAS, the undertaking would form part of the problem of repeated failures in bidding of medicine requirements for the City; inconvenience of having a non-BFAD tested supply medicines; unnecessary depletion in stock of medicine on local government hospitals and the majority of the City's public health centers;

WHEREAS, to enable the different concerned offices/departments of the City to efficiently and effectively deliver its mandated function relative to Public Health Care Program;

WHEREAS, this contract would assure the City in general and its intended beneficiaries (e.g. Quezon City General Hospital, Novaliches District Hospital, Quezon City Health Department, Social Services Development Department, Quezon City Hall Employees, etc.) in particular the timely delivery of quality and affordable prices supply of medicines;

WHEREAS, that likewise twenty percent (20%) discount be given to the City government and its employees;



NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, to enter into a negotiated contract with the Mercury Drugstore for the supply and delivery of medicinal requirements and other medical benefit of the City government and its employees, respectively.
