RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2336**S-2003

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATED CONTRACT/S WITH REPUTABLE AND QUEZON CITY-ACCREDITED CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION/S FOR THE CONCRETING OF PATHWALKS, CONSTRUCTION OF WAITING SHEDS OF TODA TERMINALS, CONSTRUCTION/REPAIR OF MULTI-PURPOSE HALL AND DAY CARE CENTER/S AND INSTALLATION OF BASKETBALL BOARDS WITH RINGS IN DISTRICT II, THIS CITY, AT SUCH AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P2,500,000.00) TO BE CHARGED AGAINST THE CAPITAL OUTLAY FOR PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL'S BUDGET FOR 2003.

WHEREAS, the concreting of pathwalks, construction of waiting sheds of TODA Terminals, construction/repair of multi-purpose hall and daycare centers and installation of basketball boards with rings at various barangay in District II, Quezon City, are among the priority development projects of the Quezon City government to promote and enhance the health, safety and convenience of the city constituents;

WHEREAS, time is of essence due to the urgency of the above-proposed projects with the rising cost of labor and materials, and in order to avoid unnecessary delay attendant to the normal conduct of public bidding, it is deemed expedient that the City government enters into negotiated contract/s for the early completion of the above-stated projects;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b)(I)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor "shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the sangguniang panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance".


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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into negotiated contract/s with reputable and Quezon City accredited construction corporation/s for the concreting of pathwalks, construction of waiting sheds of TODA terminals, construction/repair of multi-purpose hall and day care centers and installation of basketball boards with rings in District II, this City, at such amount not exceeding Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,500,000.00) to be charged against the Capital Outlay for Public Infrastructure of the Quezon City Council's Budget for 2003.
