RESOLUTION NO. SP-2345thS-2003

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE INCREASE OF THE ROUTE MEASURE CAPACITY (RMC) OF BAGUMBAYAN IN THE 3rd DISTRICT OF QUEZON CITY, FROM THE ORIGINAL NUMBER OF THIRTY - SEVEN (37) TO SEVENTY-SEVEN (77) UNITS, THUS PROVIDING FOR AN ADDITIONAL FORTY (40) UNITS TO BE REGISTERED.

WHEREAS, Bagumbayan Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association is duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission, the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, Tricycle Regulatory Unit, the LTO and LTFRB;

WHEREAS, the Route Measure Capacity (RMC) of the Bagumbayan Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association was determined based on data in the early 1990's and definitely is no longer applicable at the present situation;

WHEREAS, the increase in the number of population and the riding public which leads to an increase in the number of trips and higher demand in public transportation necessitates for an increase in the RMC;

WHEREAS, the increase in the number of RMC will allow the legalization of the number of colorums plying the route of the said TODA.
