RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2348**, S-2003

A RESOLUTION GRANTING ADDITIONAL THIRTY (30) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY SAN ANTONIO-PARKWAY VILLAGE TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION, (SAPV TODA), DISTRICT I, THIS CITY.

Introduced by Councilors RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., and RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996, and 1999, new illegally operating tricycle units continue to thrive and proliferate in the City which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycle established by the ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Boards, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchised (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchises to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 197, S-2003 approved on September 13, 2003 by the barangay council of Barangay San Antonio, District I, this City, request the City Council to grant additional Thirty (30) RMC to SAPV TODA in order to cater the needs of the constituents of said barangay and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application for additional units will serve more people in the community;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.
