WHEREAS, as provided for in the resolution passed by the PAG-ASA TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (PAG-ASA TODA), INCORPORATED, whereby it was adopted by the Board of Directors to provide for One Hundred (100) additional ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) to augment the increasing demand of tricycle commuters in their franchise route;
