A RESOLUTION GRANTING ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES TO SEVENTY-FOUR (74) PETITIONERS FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY PROJECT 6 - CARMEL - VISAYAS - CONGRESSIONAL TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (PROJECT 6 CVC TODA), INCORPORATED BARANGAY PROJECT 6, DISTRICT I, THIS CITY

WHEREAS, in a resolution passed by the PROJECT 6-CARMEL - VISAYAS - CONGRESSIONAL TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (PROJECT 6-CVC TODA), INCORPORATED, that was adopted by the Board of Directors which provide for Seventy-Four (74) additional Route Measured Capacity (RMC) to augment the increasing demand of tricycle commuters in their franchise route;
