RESOLUTION NO. SP **2361**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO (662) FAMILIES, VICTIMS OF THE JULY 10, 2000 TRASH SLIDE TRAGEDY AT PAYATAS DUMPSITE AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (P1,986,000.00) TO BE CHARGED FROM THE CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE THEREOF.

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation made by the Social Services Development Department (SSDD) the recovery and rehabilitation are not yet fully attained by the Payatas tragedy victims;

WHEREAS, emotionally and psychologically the victims feel that the recovery is still beyond their capacity due to many losses of lives;

WHEREAS, they are still in need and cannot cope-up financial assistance amounting to Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) each;

WHEREAS, it is true that the City government has given financial assistance to those who died in the trash tragedy, but there is still a need to extend financial assistance to the families of the survivors who were fortunate enough not to have perished, but whose lives were greatly affected after the tragedy.


