RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2365, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR. TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE CENTERS FOR THE ULTIMATE REHABILITATION OF DRUG DEPENDENTS (PNP-CUREDD), CAMP BAGONG DIWA, TAGUIG, TO PROVIDE DAILY SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE FOR BONAFIDE QUEZON CITY RESIDENT-DRUG REHABILITEES CONFINED IN THE PNP-CUREDD.

Introduced by Councilors JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, ERIC Z. MEDINA, MARY ANN L. SUSANO, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN.

WHEREAS, the implementation of Republic Act 9165, has mandated the voluntary or compulsory rehabilitation and treatment of drug dependents for a period not less than six (6) months;

WHEREAS, in compliance with the statutory mandate, the Government of the Philippines, including its political subdivisions and law enforcement agencies, maintains and operates rehabilitation and treatment facilities for illegal-drug dependents who are required to undergo rehabilitation and treatment;

WHEREAS, the State as *parens patriae* is duty bound to provide for the complete treatment and rehabilitation of drug dependents until their re-integration into the mainstream of Philippine society.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Philippine National Police Centers for the Ultimate Rehabilitation of Drug Dependents (PNP-CUREDD) to provide daily subsistence allowance, in an amount not exceeding Seventy Pesos (PhP70.00) and for a period of not more than six (6) months, for every bonafide resident-drug rehabilitee from Quezon City confined in the PNP-CUREDD.


