A RESOLUTION GRANTING ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES TO SIXTY (60) PETITIONERS FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY BANLAT-TANDANG SORA TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED (BTS-TODA), BARANGAY TANDANG SORA, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, as provided for in the resolution passed by Banlat - Tandang Sora Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (BTS-TODA) Inc., whereby was adopted by the Board of Directors to provide for sixty (60) additional Route Measured Capacity (RMC) to augment the increasing demand of tricycle commuters in their franchise route;

WHEREAS, as provided for in a resolution passed by the Barangay Council of Tandang Sora, District II, this City, requesting the City Council for additional sixty (60) additional Route Measured Capacity of BTS-TODA;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government in response to the growing population of the different barangays and other outlying areas in the community of the City and more effective delivery of public service has to respond to the need of its people;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.


  
  


NOW, THEREFORE,
