RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2372**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION GRANTING ADDITIONAL SEVENTY-FIVE (75) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY QUIRINO TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (QUITODA), DISTRICT III, THIS CITY.

Introduced by Councilors RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, ERIC Z. MEDINA, MARY ANN L. SUSANO, JORGE L. BANAL and JULIAN M.L. COSETENG.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996 and 1999, new illegally operating tricycle units continue to thrive and proliferate in the City which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycles established by the Route Measured Capacity (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchised (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchises to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution No. 06, S-2003 of QUITODA, whereby the Board of Directors on October 14, 2003 sought for an additional Seventy-Five (75) RMC;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 049, S-2003 approved by the Barangay Council of Barangay Quirino 2-C on November 17, 2003, and Resolution No. 75, S-2003 approved by the Barangay Council of Barangay Quirino 3-B (Claro) on November 22, 2003, District III, this City, requests the City Council to grant additional seventy-five (75) units to QUITODA in order to cater the needs of the constituents of said barangays and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application for additional units will service more people in the community;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.
