RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2376, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO FOSSIL FUELS, INCORPORATED, FOR THE OPERATION OF A GASOLINE STATION LOCATED AT NEA COMPOUND, LUZON AVENUE CORNER COMMONWEALTH AVENUE, BARANGAY MATANDANG BALARA, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, petitioner Fossil Fuels, Inc. is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit (SUP) for the operation of a gasoline station to be located at NEA Compound, Luzon Avenue corner Commonwealth Avenue, Quezon City, classified as a Major Commercial (C-2) Zone;

WHEREAS, gasoline stations are among the uses which require a Special Use Permit upon authorization from the Quezon City Council as provided for in Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Zoning Ordinance of 2000";

WHEREAS, petitioner Fossil Fuels, Inc., has represented that it has complied with the requirements for the issuance of a Special Use Permit as required by Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000;

WHEREAS, the construction and operation of said gasoline station will serve to promote public welfare and economic development through the projected increase of employment opportunity in Quezon City.
