A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH FIRST DEFENSE ENTERPRISES FOR THE PROJECT BARANGAY UNITS CAPABILITY BUILDING ON EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, CRIME PREVENTION AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (BANTAY SUNOG SA BARANGAY).

WHEREAS, this project aims to maintain a peaceful business and residential environment in Quezon City, educate residents and business entities on emergency management and crime prevention, to upgrade the capability of barangay officials in responding to fire and crime emergency occurrences, and to prevent crime and fire occurrences in every barangay unit in the City;

WHEREAS, in the past years, we have experienced traumatic incidents in the City, notably, the Ozone Disco, Manor Hotel and other residential fires to which until this time occurrences are not remote;

WHEREAS, it was observed that only a handful of barangay officials are able to respond to this type of emergency because it takes an average of ten minutes or more before the Bureau of Fire and Protection respond to the emergency situation;

WHEREAS, this ten minutes from the point of fire ignition towards fire spread development somewhat falls on the initiative of the barangay officials to respond;

WHEREAS, the role of the barangay officials is critical in the first minutes upon ignition of fire prior to the arrival of the personnel from the Bureau of Fire Protection, the Philippine National Police and other volunteer groups and the creation of Barangay Disaster and Emergency Management Group will lead to disaster preparedness of the barangay and deter criminal elements to go on their nefarious activities.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with First Defense Enterprises for the project Barangay Units Capability Building on Emergency Management, Crime Prevention and Environmental Protection (Bantay Sunog sa Barangay).
