A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THE QUEZON CITY PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION, REPRESENTED BY MS. FRANCISCA CASTRO, PRESIDENT, AND THE ALLIANCE OF CONCERNED TEACHERS-PHILIPPINES, INC., REPRESENTED BY MR. ANTONIO TINIO, NATIONAL CHAIRPERSON, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING OF THE ABOVE-MENTIONED TEACHERS' ORGANIZATIONS.

WHEREAS, the Office of Hon. Liza Largoza-Maza and Hon. Satur C. Ocampo of the Bayan Muna Party-List have allocated the sum of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) for the construction of the multi-purpose building intended to house the offices of the above-named organizations of teachers;

WHEREAS, the City Council has already passed Resolution No. SP-2328, S-2003, authorizing the Hon. City Mayor to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the above-named organizations for reason that the funds as here in abovementioned was coursed though the Quezon City government and the land wherein the building to be constructed is owned by the Quezon City government;
