RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2393**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (P5,000,000.00) TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS THE SHARE OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE PURCHASE OF A LOT LOCATED AT 49-C MAHINHIN STREET, BARANGAY TEACHERS VILLAGE WEST, DISTRICT IV, AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BARANGAY HALL THEREON, THE AMOUNT TO BE CHARGED AGAINST ANY AVAILABLE FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, Barangay Teachers Village West never had a permanent barangay hall since its creation;

WHEREAS, the owner of a property located at #49-C Mahinhin Street, Barangay Teachers Village West, District IV, Quezon City, has offered to sell his property for Three Million Pesos (P3,000,000.00);


WHEREAS, the Barangay Council is willing to put up One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) for the purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the allocation of Five Million Pesos (P5,000,000.00) to be made available as the share of the Quezon City government in the purchase of a lot located at No. 49-C Mahinhin Street, Barangay Teachers Village West, District IV, Quezon City, and for the construction of the Barangay Hall thereon, the amount to be charged against any available fund in the City Treasury.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished the Barangay Captain of Barangay Teachers Village West for her information.
