RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2395**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ANY REPUTABLE AND ACCREDITED CONTRACTOR TO UNDERTAKE THE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR OF VARIOUS GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES, INSTALLATION OF STREETLIGHTING FACILITIES, CONSTRUCTION OF WAITING SHEDS, ASPHALTING OF VARIOUS STREETS AND CONSTRUCTION OF MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDINGS, ALL IN DISTRICT I, THIS CITY, TO BE TAKEN FROM THE 2004 INFRASTRUCTURE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City government is mandated to regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks, and other public buildings/structures and approve the construction, improvement repair and maintenance of the same for public use;

WHEREAS, there is a need to improve the present condition of various government-owned infrastructures within its jurisdiction, so as to increase the efficiency and effective delivery of basic public services;

WHEREAS, the local executive is mandated to enter into legitimate contracts intended to improve the delivery of such services in behalf of the City;


WHEREAS, it is necessary for any local government unit to provide the public a convenient and safe environment, in order to achieve and realize the aforesaid objective.

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte Jr., City Mayor, this City, to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable and accredited contractor to undertake the construction and repair of various government buildings and structures, installation of streetlighting facilities, construction of waiting sheds, asphaltting of various streets and construction of multi-purpose buildings, all in District I, this City, to be taken from the 2004 Infrastructure Budget.
