RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2396, S-2004

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE ADDITIONAL TWENTY-FIVE (25) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE-FOR-HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY GREATER LA LOMA TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (GREATER LA LOMA), DISTRICT I, THIS CITY.

Introduced by Councilors RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, VOLTAIRE GODOFREDO L. LIBAN III, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, JORGE L. BANAL, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, FRANZ S. PUMAREN, WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY, RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO and XYRUS L. LANOT.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996, and 1999, new illegally operating tricycle units continue to thrive and proliferate in the City which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycle established by the Route Measured Capacity (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchise (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchise to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, as provided for in Resolution No. 121, S-2002, approved by the Barangay Council of Barangay Paang Bundok on November 3, 2002 District I, this City, requesting the City Council to grant additional Twenty-Five (25) units to Greater La Loma TODA in order to cater the needs of the constituents of said barangay and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application units will serve more people in the community.

WHEREAS, as provided in the said resolution that the proposed route shall be within Barangay Paang Bundok to E. Rodriguez Jr. High School, Mayon St., Ramon Magsaysay Elementary School in Quezon City, and vice versa;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognize the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.
