RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2397, S-2004

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., THIS CITY, TO CONVENE THE "VENDORS REGISTRATION AND SECURITY COUNCIL", SO AS TO PREPARE AN IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY THEREFOR."

WHEREAS, the City government is mandated by the Philippine Constitution to promote the welfare and protection of its constituency, which includes the residents who ply their trade in the city as their source of livelihood;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-1364, S-2003, provides, to wit:

"Creation and Composition: VENDORS REGISTRATION AND SECURITY COUNCIL. There is hereby created a VENDORS REGISTRATION AND SECURITY COUNCIL composed of the following:

3.1 Chairperson

3.2 Members

- 3.2.1 Chief, Business Permits and Licensing Office
- 3.2.2 Head, Department of Public Order and Safety
- 3.2.3 Head, City Planning and Development Office
- 3.2.4 Chief, Task Force Sikap Buhay
- 3.2.5 District Director, Central Police District Office
- 3.2.6 Chairperson, City Council Committee on Markets and Slaughterhouses
- 3.2.7 At least two (2) representatives of vendors' associations, duly accredited by the City Council pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-23, S-92, to be appointed by the City Mayor"


WHEREAS, however, the said Council has not yet convened, thus, it impedes full implementation of the said Ordinance;

WHEREAS, moreover, the said provision makes it imperative on the aforesaid Council to regularly convene and to dispose the following functions, to wit;

"SECTION 4. Functions. The Vendors Registration and Security Council shall perform the following functions:

- 4.1 Formulate policies and programs that will accord protection and security to registered and accredited vendors or peddlers;
- 4.2 Recommend appropriate measures to the City Mayor to enhance the participation of vendors in local socio-economic development efforts;
- 4.3 Conduct regular surveys on vacant areas for vending;
- 4.4 Monitor and ensure that order and discipline is maintained within the vicinity of all marketplaces."


WHEREAS, the same Ordinance necessitates an inter-agency involvement in the determination of the appropriate vending area for the registered street vendors, in order to effect full implementation of the aforesaid objective.




NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, this City, to convene the "Council for the Security of Street Vendors", so as to prepare an implementing rules and regulations necessary therefor.
