RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2400**S-2004

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AN ADDITIONAL SIXTY-EIGHT (68) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE-FOR-HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY BARANGAY SOUTH TRIANGLE TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (BST TODA), DISTRICT IV, THIS CITY.

Introduced by Councilor RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996, and 1999, new illegally operating tricycle units continue to thrive and proliferate in the City which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycle established by the Route Measured Capacity (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchised (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchise to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 002, S-2004 approved by the Barangay Council of Barangay South Triangle on January 9, 2004, requests the City Council to grant additional sixty-eight (68) units to BST TODA in order to cater the needs of the constituents of said barangay and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application units will serve more people in the community;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.



NOW, THEREFORE,


