RESOLUTION NO. SP-2402, S-2004

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO CAUSE THE APPROPRIATION/ALLOCATION OF FUNDS FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF UTILITY MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE OFFICIAL USE OF EACH OF THE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN QUEZON CITY, TO BE INCLUDED IN OR SOURCED FROM THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS IN THE CITY TREASURY.


WHEREAS, public elementary and secondary schools are primarily tasked in constructively molding our school children and high school students to become future leaders by teaching them starting from the rudiments of the alphabets, the right values and attitudes, the arts and sciences, among others, in their formative years in life and in giving them quality education to adequately prepare them for higher education;

WHEREAS, for similar reasons, that all the barangays of Quezon City were/are to be provided by the City government with motor vehicles like the Central Police District in order to enhance their mobility and effectivity in the performance of their functions, there is also a felt need to provide a utility motor vehicle to every public elementary and secondary school in Quezon City for the official use of the school's faculty and administrative staff in order to enhance their mobility as well as for use in emergencies in the school premises or whenever the contingency for its use arises, education-wise;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby strongly urge, Honorable City Mayor Feliciano Belmonte, Jr., to cause the appropriation/allocation of funds for the procurement of utility motor vehicles for the official use of each of the public elementary and secondary schools in Quezon City, to be included in or sourced from the annual budget of the Local School Board or from any available funds in the City Treasury.
