RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2408 , S-2004

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (P5,688,000.00) FROM THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD FOR THE PURCHASE OF A ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR (1,264) SQUARE METERS PARCEL OF LAND FOR THE PROPOSED GULOD HIGH SCHOOL LOCATED AT VILLAREAL STREET, BARANGAY GULOD, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, under the 1987 Philippine Constitution, it is one of the State policies to give priority to education, to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;

WHEREAS, due to lack of public high school in Barangay Gulod, those who graduated from the elementary schools within Barangay Gulod are forced to enroll in various high schools, mostly in private schools, which are far from their residences;


WHEREAS, Barangay Gulod is one of the most thickly populated in the City, has a total elementary graduates of One Thousand Five Hundred (1,500) per school year based on statistics;

WHEREAS, Barangay Officials of Barangay Gulod have expressed their willingness to establish a barangay high school in their area.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to allocate, as it does hereby allocate, the amount of Five Million Six Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Pesos (P5,688,000.00) from the Local School Board for the purchase of a One Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-Four (1,264) square meters parcel of land for the proposed Gulod High School located at Villareal Street, Barangay Gulod, Quezon City.
