RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2411, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO TRANS-ASIA PHILIPPINES, INC., FOR THE OPERATION OF ITS GLOBE AND ISLACOM CELLULAR MOBILE TRANSMISSION SYSTEM IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, petitioner, TRANS-ASIA PHILIPPINES, INC., is applying for the issuance of a Special Use Permit (SUP) for the operation of ten (10) Globe and Islacom Cellular Mobile Transmitting System (CMTS) as part of the expansion program of its facilities in Quezon City. 7. 947 Emilia Yu Bldg., (Philam Homes), EDSA
8. 1103 EDSA, Brgy. Veterans Village
9. 500 Quirino Hi-way, Bagbag, Novaliches
10. CREBA Center Bldg., Roces Ave., cor. South "A" St., Brgy. Paligsahan

WHEREAS, petitioner, TRANS-ASIA PHILIPPINES, INC., has represented that it has complied with the requirements for the issuance of a Special Use Permit as required by Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, otherwise known as the "Quezon City Zoning Ordinance of 2000";

WHEREAS, Cellular Mobile Transmitting System (CMTS) is among the uses which require a Special Use Permit upon authorization from the Quezon City Council as provided for in Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000;


WHEREAS, the operation of a CMTS will promote public convenience and economic development in Quezon City;


