RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2417, S-2004

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF THE PHILIPPINES IN THE AMOUNT OF ELEVEN MILLION PESOS (P11,000,000.00) IN FAVOR OF ABS-CBN FOUNDATION, INC., THROUGH THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ITS VARIOUS PROGRAMS AT THE LA MESA DAM BIO-DIVERSITY AND NATURE PARK ECOLOGY CENTER.

WHEREAS, the ABS-CBN Foundation, Inc./Bantay Kalikasan is the prime mover and proponent of various environment and ecology programs at the La Mesa Dam Resort Zone;

WHEREAS, these programs and activities are geared towards reviving and conserving the last and remaining forest cover of the National Capital Region, incidentally located within the jurisdiction of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, the ABS-CBN Foundation has received various assistance fund/grants from the Honorable Members of the Senate of the Philippines in the amount of Eleven Million Pesos (Php11,000,000.00) for various environment and ecology-related infrastructure, with the Quezon City government as conduit.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to accept, as it does hereby accept, the donation of the Honorable Members of the Senate of the Philippines in the amount of Eleven Million Pesos (P 11,000,000.00) for the implementation of various programs of the ABS-CBN Foundation, Inc. at the La Mesa Dam Bio-Diversity and Nature Park Ecology Center, with the Quezon City government as conduit and with the following details:

1.0 Three Million Pesos (P3,000,000.00) for the construction of a multi-purpose building from the Office of the Hon. Noli De Castro;


2.0 Three Million Pesos (P3,000,000.00) for the establishment of an orchidarium/eco-gardens from the Office of the Hon. Franklin M. Drilon;

3.0 Three Million Pesos (P3,000,000.00) for the construction of a laboratory/museum from the Office of the Hon. Loren Legarda-Leviste;

4.0 Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) for the construction of an eco-library/ administration building from the Office of the Hon. Francis P. Pangilinan.


