A RESOLUTION URGING THE BARANGAY OFFICIALS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY-TWO (142) BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY TO CONDUCT INFORMATION DRIVES TO THEIR CONSTITUENTS TO CONSERVE AND ECONOMIZE THE CONSUMPTION OF WATER TO HELP PREVENT A WATER CRISIS.


WHEREAS, there have been reports lately that the water level at the La Mesa Dam in Bulacan which supplies water to the rest of Metro Manila is dipping into its lowest level which could trigger a water crisis in Metro Manila in the coming months unless measures are instituted to mitigate if not prevent it;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that constituents of Quezon City should be informed of this alarming situation and mobilize to help in the prevention of an impending water crisis that could adversely affect the health and convenience of all Metro Manila residents.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, all barangay officials of the one hundred forty-two (142) barangays of Quezon City to conduct information drives to their constituents to conserve/economize the consumption of water to help prevent a water crisis.
