RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2445** S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., QUEZON CITY MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ANY ACCREDITED AND REPUTABLE CONSTRUCTION FIRM FOR THE CONTINUING RENOVATION OF THE LEGISLATIVE WING, TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND.

WHEREAS, local government units shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers, necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essentials to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, the legislative wing is currently undergoing structural and architectural renovations to improve its function and utility as an equal partner of the City government in policy formulation and civil governance;


WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Quezon City government to ensure the completion of the Legislative Wing Renovation Program;

WHEREAS, Section 455 (b)(1)(vi), Republic Act 7160, as amended, empowers the City Mayor to represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf contracts upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with any accredited and reputable construction firm for the continuing renovation of the Legislative Wing, covering the Carlos Albert Session Hall, Office of the Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, Office of the Vice Mayor, City Councilors' Offices and Legislative Committee Function Rooms, including the Development of the Archival System of the Legislative Department, to be taken from the 2004 Infrastructure Fund.


