RESOLUTION NO. SP- 2453, S-2004

A RESOLUTION GRANTING AN ADDITIONAL TWENTY-NINE (29) ROUTE MEASURED CAPACITY (RMC) FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE WITHIN THE ROUTE COVERED BY DON ANTONIO VETERANS TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION (DAVTODA), DISTRICT II, THIS CITY.

Introduced by Councilors RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN, VICTOR V. FERRER, JR., ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, MARY ANN L. SUSANO, JORGE L. BANAL, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY and ANTONIO E. INTON, JR.

WHEREAS, despite the legalization program for colorum tricycle units implemented in 1994, 1996, and 1999, new illegally operating tricycle units continue to thrive and proliferate in the City which had deprived legitimate franchise holders in the right income they deserve;

WHEREAS, in attempting to meet such problems, notwithstanding, the number of tricycles established by the Route Measured Capacity (RMC) as the appropriate level of demand, the members of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board, agreed in principle, to legalize all existing unfranchised (colorum) tricycle units in Quezon City by recommending the granting of additional franchises to the Quezon City Council;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 01, S-2003 of DAVTODA, adopted by the Board of Directors on September 25, 2003, seeks for the legalization of their existing twenty-nine (29) colorums;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 002, S-2004 approved by the Barangay Council of Barangay Holy Spirit, District II, this City, on January 26, 2004, requests the City Council to grant additional RMC to DAVTODA, as per inventory by the Tricycle Regulation Unit (TRU) and the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB), in order to cater the needs of the constituents of said barangay and for the safety of its passengers, and that, said application for additional units will serve more people in the community;

WHEREAS, based on the barangay resolution/endorsement for additional franchises for approval, the same shall be based on the actual inspected units by TFB and TRU;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City government recognizes the importance of an efficient and affordable transport system for public convenience.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED to grant, as it does hereby grant, an additional Route Measure Capacity for the operation of motorized tricycles-for-hire within the route covered by Don Antonio Veterans Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (DAVTODA), District II, this City.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the concerned barangay and offices for their information and appropriate action.
