RESOLUTION NO. SP-**2484**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE METRO MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA) AND THE PASIG RIVER REHABILITATION COMMISSION FOR A THREE (3) YEAR MORATORIUM ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE UNIFORM THREE (3) METER EASEMENT ALONG THE PASIG RIVER SYSTEM INCLUDING ITS TRIBUTARIES, FROM THE EXISTING SHORELINES AND RIVER BANKS OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTIES LOCATED IN AREAS OF AFFECTED BARANGAYS IN QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by Councilors ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, RAMON P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and RESTITUTO B. MALANGEN.

WHEREAS, the residents of affected areas fear that the implementation of the three (3) meter easement will result to the demolition of their houses which will result to their displacement, and in order to avoid and prevent the mass house demolition and relocation of affected residents in the concerned areas, it is proper and appropriate that the City Council should request for a three (3) year moratorium on the implementation of the uniform three (3) meter easement along the Pasig River System including its tributaries.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to request, as it does hereby request, the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) and the Pasig River Rehabilitation Commission for a three (3) year moratorium on the implementation of the uniform three (3) meter easement along the Pasig River System including its tributaries, from existing shorelines and river banks of public and privately owned properties located in areas of affected barangays in Quezon City.
