RESOLUTION NO. SP. 2492, S-2004

A RESOLUTION URGING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, THIS CITY, TO PURCHASE TWO (2) HAND RADIO COMMUNICATIONS REPEATER EACH FOR EVERY BARANGAY IN QUEZON CITY, AND APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR, TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, it is inherent to any local government unit to address the increasing demand for a more effective delivery of public service, thus, it is necessary to have a reliable, synchronized, and efficient means of communication in order to immediately act on matters of vital concern;

WHEREAS, the barangays, being in the forefront of public service, is tasked to act and carry out measures as may be necessary during emergency situations which concerns peace and order and in the aftermath of any man-made or natural calamities:

WHEREAS, in order to achieve the aforesaid objective, it is practically necessary to provide the barangays with effective radio communications in order to satisfy the aforesaid demand.
