RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2494**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND BETWEEN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, REPRESENTED BY THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., WITH THE PHILIPPINE RURAL RECONSTRUCTION MOVEMENT (PRRM), REPRESENTED BY ITS PRESIDENT, ATTY. WIGBERTO E. TAÑADA, FOR THE MAINTENANCE, REHABILITATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE OPEN SPACE FRONTING THE PHILIPPINE RURAL RECONSTRUCTION MOVEMENT BUILDING AT THE CORNER OF MOTHER IGNACIA AND DR. LAZCANO STREETS, BARANGAY SOUTH TRIANGLE, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Republic Act Number 7160, otherwise known as the "The Local Government Code of 1991" provides that local government units shall likewise exercise such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provision of the basic services and facilities enumerated in the Code;

WHEREAS, The Philippine Rural Reconstruction Movement (PRRM), an accredited non-government organization duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, which is committed to contribute to the community in conserving and enhancing the environment, has adopted that parcel of land owned by the Quezon City government situated at the corner of Mother Ignacia and Dr. Lazcano Streets, Barangay South Triangle, to be developed into a mini park, with the permission of the latter, hence, both parties formalized their agreement with the execution of the attached Memorandum of Agreement on January 19, 2004.




