RESOLUTION NO. SP-2507, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO MORE THAN TWO HUNDRED (200) FAMILIES AFFECTED BY THE FIRE THAT RAZED A RESIDENTIAL AREA IN J. P. RIZAL ST., BARANGAY SAN ROQUE AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY OTHER AVAILABLE FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY.

WHEREAS, a fire razed houses at the residential area of J.P. Rizal Street Barangay San Roque on April 25, 2004.









BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, to extend financial assistance to more than Two Hundred (200) families affected by the fire that razed a residential area in J. P. Rizal St., Brgy. San Roque, at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer, the fund to be taken from the Calamity or Emergency Fund of the City Government or from any available fund in the City Treasury.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Social Services Development Department, in coordination with the Barangay official of Barangay San Roque, shall authenticate the beneficiaries of this assistance.


