RESOLUTION NO. SP-2513, S-2004

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE APRIL 25, 2004 VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF ONE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE (145) FAMILIES AT 237 J. P. RIZAL AND 529 BONI SERRANO STREET, SAN ROQUE II, BARANGAY BAGONG PAG-ASA, DISTRICT I, QUEZON CITY, AT TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) PER FAMILY OWNER AND ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY RENTER/SHARER, WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on April 25, 2004 Barangay Bagong Pag-asa, specifically 237 J.P. Rizal and 529 Boni Serrano Streets, San Roque II was hit by fire that burned the houses of One hundred Forty Five (145) families, who are now in dire need of financial assistance most especially from the City government;

WHEREAS, because of this calamity, they are experiencing difficulties resulting from the incident;

WHEREAS, it is the primary duty of the City government to extend assistance to its less fortunate constituents.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to urge, as it does hereby urge, the Honorable Mayor Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., to extend financial assistance to the April 25, 2004 victims of fire that burned the residential houses of One Hundred Forty Five (145) families at 237 J. P. Rizal and 529 Boni Serrano Street can Roque II, Barangay Bagong Pag-asa, District I, Quezon City at Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) per family owner and One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per family renter/sharer, which shall be taken from the calamity or emergency fund of the city government or from any available source of fund thereof.
