A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BY AND AMONG THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, MANILA WATER COMPANY, INC., AND BARANGAY AMIHAN, RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT (STP) IN THE AREA OF PALOSAPIS COMMUNAL SEPTIC TANK LOCATED AT PALOSAPIS STREET CORNER BATINO STREET, BARANGAY AMIHAN, PROJECT 3, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the Concession Agreement executed with the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage system (MWSS), the Manila Water Company, Inc. (MWCI) has offered to upgrade the Palosapis Street Communal Septic Tank (CST) located at Palosapis Street corner Batino Street, Barangay Amihan, Project 3, Quezon City.

WHEREAS, Barangay Amihan has accepted the said offer and has issued a Barangay Certificate for the purpose;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government has also accepted the offer subject to the terms, conditions and stipulations stated in the Memorandum of Agreement executed by the parties thereto on March 18, 2004, a copy thereof is made an integral part of this resolution.


