WHEREAS, parallel to this mandate, TELOF -NCR has requested the Quezon City government to provide an office space in order to cater the communication services to the constituents of the city;


WHEREAS, the City government accommodated the said request to carry out such functions to dutifully serve the communication needs of the residents, hence, this Resolution.
