RESOLUTION NO. SP. - 2529, 3-2004

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONDONATION OF THE INTEREST AND PENALTIES ON THE MONTHLY AMORTIZATION OF THE CITY-OWNED PROPERTIES WHICH WERE DISPOSED OF THROUGH DIRECT SALE TO THE ACTUAL OCCUPANTS AS PART OF THE SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROGRAM OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

Introduced by Councilors DANTE M. DE GUZMAN, RAMON P. MEDALLA, MARY ANN L. SUSANO, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN and RICARDO R. DEL ROSARIO.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government, in response to the implementation of its avowed policy of poverty alleviation by providing land to the landless, and home to the homeless, has disposed one (1) city-owned property through direct sale to actual occupants in support to the shelter program of the government to wit:

Name of Association : Tampoy Open Space Association, Inc.
Location : Tampoy St., Quirino 2-B, Quezon City
No. of Beneficiaries : 54

WHEREAS, these beneficiaries are now paying their monthly amortization;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council is aware that the nation has been plagued by economic crisis that further crippled members of the informal sector from paying their obligation to the City government;

WHEREAS, the beneficiaries are now requesting the City government for the condonation of penalties on the monthly amortization until such time the economic situation becomes normal.
