RESOLUTION NO. SP-2532, S-2004

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE SINCERE COMMENDATION AND CONGRATULATIONS OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO OUTGOING CITY COUNCILOR HONORABLE JORGE L. BANAL FOR HIS EXEMPLARY AND OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE AS CITY COUNCILOR REPRESENTING THE THIRD DISTRICT FOR FOUR (4) TERMS FROM 1988 TO 1991 AND FROM 1995 TO 2004.

WHEREAS, Quezon City Councilor and City Council President Pro-Tempore Jorge L. Banal is approaching the conclusion of his colorful and multi-awarded career as a four-termer City Councilor whose legislative output defined in a substantial way and distinctive manner the Quezon City government's performance profile;

WHEREAS, Honorable Jorge L. Banal was elected Councilor representing the Third District of Quezon City and served four terms in 1988 to 1991 and from 1995 to 2004 local elections;

WHEREAS, Honorable Jorge L. Banal, prior to his entry in the field of public service and governance was a distinguished businessman and who, as a respected socio-civic leader was given various recognition and awards, among which were the prestigious and highly coveted Tandang Sora Service Award (lone male awardee, the two first awardees being Rosa Rosal and Fiscal Lea Castelo); Presidential Award of Distinguished Public Service of the Order of the Knights of Rizal; Plaque of Recognition by the QC Chamber of Commerce and Industry; Gintong Ama and Model Family Awards; and various leadership and recognition awards from the Jaycees, Rotary, Lions, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, and Knights of Columbus, among others;

WHEREAS, as a City Legislator, Councilor Banal continues to serve various socio-civic organizations, among them as incumbent Chairman, Metro Manila Philippine Councilors League and NCR Chairman, Philippine Councilors League; Charter President, Rotary Club of Katipunan; past Region Chairman, Lions International, District 301-D1; National Chairman, Philippine Jaycees Senate Foundation; Charter President, Senior Citizens Scouters Association of the Philippines; Faithful Navigator, Knights of Columbus Padre Gomez Assembly; Board Member, Philippine Mental Health Association; among many other organizations;

WHEREAS, in the course of his 4-term tenure, Councilor Banal has handled the positions of President Pro-Tempore, Majority Floor Leader, 1st Assistant Majority Floor Leader, Assistant Minority Floor Leader, and held the Chairmanship of the Committee on Laws, Rules and Internal Government, Committee on Education, Committee on Culture and Tourism, Committee on People's Participation, the Blue Ribbon Committee, and by operation of law, and applying the rules on succession, was sworn into office as Vice Mayor and Presiding Officer of the City Council of Quezon City, for the period April 7 to June 1998;

WHEREAS, Honorable Banal is a "Hall of Famer" of the Manuel Luis Quezon Bantayog Award for having been a recipient of the same for three (3) years, a fitting testimonial to his outstanding performance as Quezon City alderman;




NOW, THEREFORE,
