RESOLUTION NO. SP-2542, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO ENTER INTO A NEGOTIATED CONTRACT WITH ANY REPUTABLE CONTRACTOR/S FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A BOX CULVERT AT DON JULIO GREGORIO BRIDGE ALONG SAUYO ROAD, OLD PALIGUAN CREEK, INFRONT OF THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED FOURSTOREY BUILDING OF BAGBAG ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, AND A PERIMETER WALL ALONG THE OLD CREEK AND AT THE BACK OF THE SCHOOL.

Introduced by Councilors ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., RAMON P. MEDALLA, MARY ANN L. SUSANO, DANTE M. DE GUZMAN and RESTITUTO B. MALANGEN.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to wit:

"Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted x x x as well as powers necessary x x x, promote health and safety x x x and preserved the comfort and convenience of their inhabitant."

WHEREAS, the said box culvert is located at Don Julio Gregorio Bridge along Sauyo Road, Old Paliguan Creek, which will serve as the access road/entrance of the newly constructed four-storey "SB" Building, Bagbag Elementary School;

WHEREAS, the City government has seen the need to implement immediately the construction of a box culvert infront of the said school;

WHEREAS, the perimeter wall along the old creek at the back of the building is for the safety of the school children and school properties as well;

WHEREAS, the said construction of box culvert will give additional site for the school, provide children's space for their school programs, field demonstration and serve as playground.

Belmonte, Jr., to enter into a negotiated contract with any reputable contractor/s for the construction of a box culvert at Don Julio Gregorio Bridge along Sauyo Road, Old Paliguan Creek, infront of the newly constructed four-storey building of Bagbag Elementary School, District II, Quezon City, and a perimeter wall along the creek and at the back of the school.
