RESOLUTION NO. SP- **2543**, S-2004

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO DIGITAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS PHILIPPINES, INC. (DIGITEL), THROUGH ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, JOHN JOEY T. TERRENAL, VICE PRESIDENT, NETWORK PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DIVISION, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF CELL SITES AT THIRTEEN (13) LOCATIONS, ALL IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the Digital Telecommunications Philippines, Inc. (DIGITEL), is applying for a Special Use Permit for the construction and operation of cell sites located at thirteen locations, all in Quezon City, to wit:

1. PCA Building, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City
2. Salvador Building, 16 Malindang St., Quezon City
3. AJ Building – 149 E. Garcia St., Cubao, Quezon City
4. Virata Hall – E. Jacinto St., UP Diliman, Quezon City
5. Project Condominium – Project 4, Quezon City
6. One Executive – West Ave., Quezon City
7. City Walk – East Wood City, Libis, Quezon City
8. Merville – Fairview, Quezon City
9. Marquez Lot – San Lazaro, Gulod, Novaliches
10. Saguisin – 23 Banlat Road, Quezon City
11. Llim's Lot – 49 Shorthorn St., Project 8, Quezon City
12. Daguman's Lot – Commonwealth, Quezon City
13. Wildlife – North Avenue, Quezon City

WHEREAS, the operation of the cell sites will serve to promote public welfare and economic development through the projected increase of employment opportunity and business opportunity in Quezon City,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provision of Article VII, Section 2 (h) Ordinance No. SP-918, S-2000, and its implementing rules and regulations, a Special Use Permit is required for cell sites under which the proposed project falls.


NOW, THEREFORE,
